From the Town Manager's Office

This has certainly been a very different budget process for our community. Due to the uncertainty with the State budget and its potentially dramatic impact on towns and cities, we were able to find legal means to suspend our budget process. At the point in time when a State budget is adopted and we fully understand the impact on the Town, we will at the administrative level prepare a revised budget for consideration by the Town Council. The Town Council will then have to follow all of the procedural requirements of the Town Charter, including the adoption of a budget to be submitted to referendum, hold a public hearing on the adopted budget and schedule a budget referendum and subsequent referendums if needed. Since there is no way the budget process could have been completed in time for tax bills effective July 1st, tax bills were sent out that reflect the current mill rate of 34.19 mills and, once the Town adopts a budget, supplemental tax bills will be issued to be paid as part of the second installment due in January.

Also, please be advised that the mill rate for motor vehicles based on State law is a lower mill rate at 32 mills; this is also subject to change as part of the State budget and if the state-imposed cap is raised, this increase will as well be reflected in the supplemental tax bill. It is important that if you are not signed up to receive emails from the Town regarding Town news, that you go to www.tolland.org to do so. The budget situation is very fluid and in order to get information quickly to residents, email is the most

Friendly Reminder: Tax bills were mailed at the end of June. If you have not received your tax bill, please contact the office at 860-871-3654 or 860-871-3657.

JULY INSTALLMENT

The due date is July 1, 2017 and the last day to pay without interest is Tuesday, August 1, 2017. To ensure you pay on time, please follow these guidelines.

- **1. In person** pay your bill early in the month to avoid waiting in line. Tuesday, August 1, 2017 until 4:30 pm is the last time you can pay in person.
- **2. By drop box** place your payment in the drop box outside of the main Town Hall entrance no later than 4:30 pm on Tuesday, August 1, 2017 or it will be considered late and interest will accrue.
- **3. By mail** mail your payment early in the month or bring it inside the Post Office and ask to have it "hand canceled" by a postal service employee no later than August 1, 2017. This is the only way you can ensure an on-time post mark.
- **4. Save Time and Pay Online** By electronic check or credit card go to the Town of Tolland website, www.tolland.org, **continued on page 2**

click on Help Center and Pay Taxes Online. ACH payments (electronic checks) are a flat fee of \$1.95 and credit card payment fees will be 2.95%. Your transaction must be completed no later than midnight on August 1, 2017.

JANUARY INSTALLMENT

Once the budget is approved, you will receive an Adjusted Second Installment Bill with a due date of January 1, 2018 and the last day to pay without interest is Thursday, February 1, 2018.

Interest: If payment is not made on or before the last day, your installment is delinquent and interest will be calculated at 1 ½% per month (18% per annum) from the installment due date of July 1st and January 1st with a minimum interest rate of 3% or a minimum charge of \$2.00 per bill number, as required by law.

Sometime later this year Tolland will be switching to every other week for residential pick-up of your blue recycling rolling cart. Most residents currently have a 65 gallon blue recycling rolling cart. Prior to this change, residents will be given the option of getting at no cost a larger 95 gallon blue recycling rolling cart or getting a second recycling cart. Next Town sponsored (no charge) Bulky Waste and Metal pick-up will take place during the first full week of

October 2017 (the week of October 2nd), on the same day of the week as your trash collection. A reservation is required at least (4) business days in advance of your pick-up day or your items WILL NOT be picked up.





UPDATE ON PARKER ELDERLY HOUSING PROJECT

In the coming months (if not by the time you read this), we expect to see work begin on the Parker Elderly Housing Project. The Access Agency, a non-profit affordable housing provider, will be converting the vacant portion of the school building into 37 units of elderly housing. With an increasing number of older residents and a waiting list for affordable housing, this project will fill a critical need in town.

In early 2016, Access Agency, its design team, and town staff work with the school administration, parents and residents to refine the plans to address the needs of users of the site. The busway serving the Tolland Intermediate School will be reconfigured and the parking lots will be improved. You will see some of these outdoor improvements underway this summer, with other outdoor work likely completed next summer. UPDATE ON TOLLAND GREEN ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Connecticut Department of Transportation (DOT) continues its work on the design of the Tolland Green Road Improvement Project. The project will reconfigure key intersections along the Green and deploy "traffic calming" techniques to slow traffic. DOT anticipates the design will be completed by December, with construction beginning in spring or summer of 2018.

RENTER'S REBATE

Tolland Human Services will accept Renter's Rebate applications through September 30, 2017. This income-based program provides a one-time payment to renters based on the rent and utilities paid in 2016. Recipient or spouse must be 65 years of age or older, or be 50 years of age or older and the surviving spouse of a renter who at the time of the renter's death had qualified and was entitled to tax relief provided such spouse was domiciled with such renter at the time of the renters death, or 18 years of age or older and eligible to receive Social Security Disability benefits and must meet a one year state residency requirement.

Proof of income and expenses for 2016 must be provided. Income guidelines for this year's Renter's Rebate program have not yet been provided. However, please find last year's income guidelines for your reference:




